Tour participant, **Timothy Ely** gave a lecture at the University of Washington called "The Extra-terrestrial Book" on November 5, and taught a workshop called "Sketchbooks: Thoughts and Actions," both sponsored by the Book Arts Guild.



On November 19 he is giving a lecture to the Patrons of the Lilly Library at Indiana University in Bloomington and delivering their latest acquisition, a one-of-a-kind manuscript book titled "Index," which is inspired by three roads between Colfax and Spokane -- Territorial Road, Pandora Road, and Paradise Road.

This is "Flight into Egypt: The Third Magnitude" -- a commissioned work by **Timothy Ely**, just completed. Tim calls these pieces one-of-a-kind manuscript books. This one has 20 - 14" x 22" drawings in it.
